HOUSING NEEDS

In order to progress the housing needs in our city and continue to roll out housing units for all on the waiting lists I have proposed a number of measures including raising a loan in December 2005 of approx 11 million to help Council applicants borrow to buy their home.



The exact extract of the minutes from that meeting are as follows:

- To Authorise the raising of a loan for Part V Affordable Housing at Sruthán Mhuirinne, Ballybane: It was proposed by Cllr. M.J. Crowe, and agreed to authorise the raising of a loan in the sum of €10,938,000.00 from the H.F.A. for the purpose of issuing loans to borrowers to purchase houses under the Affordable Housing Scheme.
- The development of new homes and apartments in the Merlin Park area. At the Council meeting of July 2006 I proposed that the council go ahead with a new housing project for the area which it did.

The exact extract of the minutes from that meeting are as follows;

- Cllr. M.J. Crowe then proposed that: "the Housing development at Merlin Park consisting of 93 houses and community facilities be proceeded with subject to the modifications set out in the Planners Report dated 6th June 2006 which was attached to the report of Mr. C. Hayes".

Central Heating for Ballybane Council Homes

In December 2006 I received confirmation that council owned homes in Ballybane would be fitted with central heating within the next year.

I had several meetings with the housing section about this issue, and I had made representations on behalf of a number of people who I know are in need of heating in the estate and was delighted that the Council went ahead with this much needed work.
