DOUGHISKA & ROSCAM

NEW ROAD FOR DOUGHISKA PROPOSED BY CROWE

After many years of lobbying and campaigning for the necessary road improvements to the Doughiska Road it was eventually secured in early 2008. With money secured locally and nationally the upgrading could finally go ahead and at the Council meeting in June 2008 I proposed that this would happen.



The exact extract of minutes from that meeting are as follows:

- Cllr. M.J. Crowe then formally proposed: "That the development as proposed in the Part 8 ie Proposed Road Improvements at Doughiska Road be proceeded with subject to the one condition as set out in the Planners Report dated 7/9/07".

Another major junction which caused enormous headaches was the junction located between Parkmore and Monivea Road. I live in this area and had known full well the problems that this junction was then causing.

AMENITY LANDS AND PLAYGROUND IN ROSCAM



We have learned in past times that it is necessary to build open spaces, play areas etc WITH residential developments and not to go looking for them afterwards. Part of the conditions of planning in the Roscaoin and Boireann Bheag areas was that an area like this would be also developed and its my belief that this is current best practice. The area should soon be opened to the public and I am currently working to try and achieve this as soon as possible.

EXTRACT FROM CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES DISPOSAL OF LAND:

In response to concerns raised by a number of Councillors regarding the question of access to the lands, Mr. J. O'Neill Director of Services advised that a number of discussions had been held with the V.E.C. and the Department of Education & Science regarding the question of access. He outlined to the elected Council the proposals for this access as agreed with the V.E.C. and the Department of Education and Science and it was then **proposed by Cllr. M.J. Crowe: "to resolve, pursuant to Section 183 of the Local Government Act 2001 and Section 211 of the Local Government (Planning & Development) Act 2000, the disposal of land held by Galway City Council at Doughiska, Galway to the City of Galway Vocational Education Committee as per the terms of Statutory Notice dated 23rd March, 2006 and circulated to Members"**.
