Supporting Ballinfoyle Community Centre Development

The long awaited Ballinfoyle Community Centre was finally given the go ahead by Galway City Council recently. I am delighted that this has now been approved by the Council but we have to ensure, particularly in the current difficult economic climate that it is built and if re-elected, I will continue the work to achieve this. The new facility will comprise of a sports complex, Creche, Credit Union Office and much more.

Monivea Road/Parkmore Junction

From when I was first elected it was my view that a traffic controlled junction was what was required here. I had several meetings with the officials in the Roads Section of Galway City Council and in February 2005 meeting I proposed that this occur.



The exact extract of minutes from that meeting are as follows:

- ***It was then proposed by Cllr. M. J. Crowe that; "the proposed development consisting of improvement works to the Monivea Road/Parkmore Road Junction to include traffic signals and adjustment to the tie-in with the Briarhill Roundabout (Lynch) be proceeded.***

DEALING WITH ISSUES

Crowe has worked hard in the area over the last few years assisting a number of clubs in various ways and helping them with any difficulties they may have had. Also as Chairperson of the Transport Committee Crowe met with Roads Officials on a number of occasions to discuss the Coolough junction. Finally the work has commenced to address this dangerous stretch of road and works should be completed in the coming weeks.
